



SSAA Primary 4x100m Relay Championships 2026



Grangemouth Stadium, Kersiebank Avenue, Grangemouth, FK3 0BS

Saturday 6th June 2026, approx. 12:30pm start

1. Age Groups

P6/7 Boys Participants must be in P6 or P7

P6/7 Girls Participants must be in P6 or P7

There will be 2 runs and a final.

Run 1 - all teams are involved.

Run 2 - all teams are involved. Seeding will be based on Run 1 times

Final – will consist of the 8 best team from Run 2. (e.g. 4 heats = Winner in each heat will progress to the final along with the next 4 best times.)

2. Entry Conditions

All entries must be made online.

Schools should only contact Ron Hunter by email (ssaa-events@online-entries.co.uk) if they have not received confirmation of their entries within 2 days of submission.

When confirmation of entry has been received, it must be confirmed as requested.

There is no limit on how many teams a school can enter and no qualifying standards.

3. Entry Fees

Entry fee is **£20** per team entry. The entry cost is an **ENTRY FEE** and must be paid for each team entered, whether they compete or not.

N.B. Schools will receive an Invoice with entry confirmation. This should be sent along with payment form.

4. Closing Date

The closing date for entries is **Wednesday 13th May 2026**.

No entries will be considered after the online system closes. Only corrections will be accepted.

Athletes must not be sent to Grangemouth Stadium unaccompanied.

The name of the accompanying adult/teacher/parent must be entered on the entry form. This person should be available to officiate in some capacity on the day.

5. Refunds

Please note there will be no refunds should a competitor withdraw after the official closing date.
