

SSAA Road Race Championships 2026

Wednesday, 7th October 2026
Pittencrieff Park, Dunfermline

Events: This is a short distance road race for individuals with a Team element. There will be 13 races.

Race 1A – Girls (born between 01/03/16 & 28/02/17) – Approx 1600m – 11.30 am start

Race 1B – Boys (born between 01/03/16 & 28/02/17) – Approx 1600m – 11.45 am start

Race 2A – Girls (born between 01/03/15 & 29/02/16) – Approx 1600m – 12 noon start

Race 2B – Boys (born between 01/03/15 & 29/02/16) – Approx 1600m – 12.15 pm start

Declarations for the above 4 races close 30 minutes before start of race

Race 3 – Girls (born between 01/03/14 & 28/02/15) – Approx. 2400m – 12.30 pm start

Race 4 – Boys (born between 01/03/14 & 28/02/15) – Approx. 2400m – 12.45 pm start

Declarations for Race 3 close at 12 noon and for Race 4 at 12.15 pm

Race 5 – Girls (born between 01/03/13 – 28/02/14) – Approx. 2400m – 1 pm start

Race 6 – Boys (born between 01/03/13 – 28/02/14) – Approx. 2400m – 1.15 pm start

Declarations for Race 5 close at 12.30 pm and for Race 6 at 12.45 pm

Race 8 – Girls (born between 01/03/11 – 28/02/13) – Approx. 3200m - 1.45 pm start

Race 9 – Boys (born between 01/03/11 – 28/02/13) – Approx. 4800m – 2.05 pm start

Declarations for Race 8 close at 1.15 pm and for Race 9 at 1.35 pm

Race 10 – Girls (born on or before 28/02/11) – Approx. 3200m – 2.25 pm start

Race 11 – Boys (born on or before 28/02/11) – Approx. 4800m – 2.45 pm start

Declarations for Race 10 close at 1.55 pm and for Race 11 at 2.15 pm

Closing Date: **CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES IS MONDAY 21st SEPTEMBER 2026**

Awards: The runners finishing in 1st, 2nd & 3rd places in each race will receive an SSAA medal. An Age Group Trophy will be presented to the 1st placed team with 4 runners to count. The Trophy will be retained for one year.

Entry Conditions: There is no limit on the number of individuals a school may enter in each event. 4 members are required to count towards a team award. Name and Date of Birth of all athletes being entered must be submitted on the entry form.

Race 7 – The Para Event is open to race bikes, race chairs and ambulant runners. Entries should be direct to Margaret McNally – theoaks4@aol.com The School does not have to be affiliated for these Athletes to compete. Name, School/College, Date of Birth and Classification must be included.

Entry for all other races is via the web site and must be made by 21/09/26 from an education email address.

Course : The course is mainly on 4m wide tarmac paths within Pittencrieff Park.

Numbers: School envelopes with individual Chipped Numbers will be issued at Declarations. The number should be worn on the FRONT of the schools' vest. **CLUB COLOURS MUST NOT BE WORN.** Please bring your own pins.

It is important that each athlete wears the correct chipped number, and each School Representative should check this carefully when handing out the individual numbers.

We cannot accept responsibility for an individual result when the incorrect number is worn.

Entry fee: The entry fee per individual athlete will be £10 and must be paid whether the athlete competes or not.

Entries for this event will be submitted via Open Track. Information will be sent to schools as soon as details have been finalised.

Accompanying Adult: All schools must name a PVG Registered adult who will be attending this event. This adult may be asked to officiate (no experience necessary) and will be the contact in case of emergency.

Changing Facilities: Changing facilities are available within the Glen Pavilion. Valuables should not be left in this area and please leave the area clean and tidy.
